Matric Sci-Bono Trip

On 28 May 2026, our Matric class visited Sci-Bono Discovery Centre in Newtown. Purpose of the trip: To reinforce Grade 12 physics, chemistry, and biology concepts through hands-on learning, and to boost confidence ahead of final exams. The interactive exhibits on force, energy, and circuits helped learners connect theory to real-world applications. Live science shows and problem-solving zones also sharpened critical thinking and teamwork. The Matrics especially engaged with exam-focused displays that mirror final paper questions, giving them practical ways to recall concepts under pressure. Many learners noted how seeing concepts “in action” made revision feel less abstract. The trip also reminded them that science is collaborative – asking questions and testing ideas together builds deeper understanding. Learners returned with clearer understanding and fresh motivation – a reminder that science is lived, not just memorized. Thank you to our educators and Sci-Bono for making it a safe, valuable day. To our Matrics: take that insight into your final stretch. We believe in you.

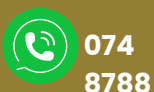
